## **AN UPDATE ON CHANGES TO THE SCHOOL ROUTINE.**

All decisions are being made in line with the advice to ALL schools.

### **Assemblies**

In line with the recommendations for schools to practice social distancing there will be **no Parent Assemblies** until further notice.

### **Parent Teacher Interviews**

Face to face interviews are **cancelled**. Parents will be able to **email teachers** to ask questions or discuss any concerns. Any important issues can be discussed via phone call.

### **Playgroup and The Daily Grind @WCS Café.**

Playgroup has been **indefinitely postponed**. The Daily Grind @WCS Café will be **closed** until further notice.

### **Family Picnic**

The upcoming Family Picnic event has been **postponed** until further notice.

### **Sewing Club**

Afternoon Sewing Club is cancelled.

### **Excursions and Sport**

All **excursions** and **interschool sporting events** scheduled for the remainder of Term One have been reviewed and **will not go ahead**.

- **Moorambilla** Auditions and events have been **cancelled**.
- **Anzac March** will **not go ahead**.
- We will hold our own **Cross-Country** day within our school grounds. This will be a **student only** day to maintain our strong social distancing protocols. The **Easter celebration lunch** will still happen for **students only**.

### **Classrooms**

All classrooms have been supplied with **hand soap and a wash station**. Students are being encouraged to wash hands regularly, particularly before and after recess and lunch, and after sneezing or coughing.

**Extra wash stations** have been installed in the student bubbler area. Some bubblers have been converted to taps to allow for easier access to soap and water. Soap supplies in student bathrooms are continually monitored.

**Surfaces** in classrooms are being regularly cleaned and disinfected.

### **Social Distancing and Hand, Sneeze and Cough protocols.**

All students are aware of the appropriate hand, sneeze and cough etiquette and they are **reminded regularly** by teachers and with posters around the school.

Students are asked to leave a safe '**space bubble**' around them when they sit in class and whilst eating and playing outside. They have been encouraged to imagine an invisible person next to them, to leave enough space.
