

PHASE 0

WCS is open for families who need it.

4 MAY – 8 MAY

- Families are encouraged to keep their children at home wherever possible, with no student to be turned away.
- Students who attend school are supervised only with online learning, not in their regular classes.
- No assemblies, excursions, sport or inter-school activities.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

You must continue to

- Keep your child/children at home if possible, including if they are unwell in any way.
- Support your child/children to continue learning at home.
- Communicate with school via email and phone wherever possible.

PHASE 1

Students return to school one day per week.

11 MAY-22 MAY

- Each class will attend school one day per week.
 - **Monday- Kinder**
 - **Tuesday – 1/2**
 - **Wednesday – 3/4**
 - **Thursday- 5/6**
- No indoor assemblies, excursions, sport or inter-school activities.
- Families who need to send their child to school every day may continue to do so. No child will be turned away.
- Students who attend school are supervised with online learning, not in their regular classes.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

You can now

- Send your child to school one day per week according to the letter dated **29 April 2020**.

You must continue to

- Follow school advice regarding changes to drop off and pick up.
- Maintain social distancing by avoiding entering or gathering inside the school grounds.
- Support your child/children to continue learning at home on remote learning days.
- Follow health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell.
- Communicate with school via email and phone when required.

PHASE 2

Students at school two days a week, with social distancing measures.

25 MAY-29 MAY

- Each class will attend school on two consecutive days per week.
 - **Monday Tuesday- Kinder**
 - **Monday Tuesday- Year 1/2**
 - **Wednesday Thursday- Year 3/4**
 - **Wednesday Thursday- Year 5/6**
- No indoor assemblies, excursions, sport or inter-school activities.
- Families who need to send their child to school every day may continue to do so. No child will be turned away.
- Students who attend school are supervised with online learning, not in their regular classes.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school two days per week.

You must continue

- Follow school advice regarding changes to drop off and pick up.
- Maintain social distancing by avoiding entering or gathering inside the school grounds.
- Support your child/children to continue learning at home on remote learning days.
- Follow health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell.

PHASE 2

Students at school five days per week, with social distancing measures.

FROM 1 JUNE

- Students with increased health risks may continue to learn at home to suit their individual needs.
- Remote Learning ends.
- No indoor assemblies, excursions or inter-school activities.
- Continued enhanced cleaning and hygiene supply arrangements.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school every day.
- Visit the school office where appropriate hygiene measures are in place.
- Walk your child/children into and out of school while maintaining social distancing subject to school advice.

You must continue to

- Follow school advice regarding changes to drop off and pick up.
- Maintain social distancing by avoiding gathering inside the school grounds.
- Follow health advice and keep your child/children at home if they are unwell.
- Communicate with school via email and phone when required.

PHASE 3

Students at school five days per week, with full school activities.

FROM 21 JULY (subject to Government advice)

- Normal school day and entry/exit processes will resume.
- Infection control procedures will continue on a case by case basis.
- Communication to staff, students and families regarding NSW Health advice will continue.

You can now

- Send your child/children to school every day.
- Participate in school assemblies, excursions and inter-school activities.
- Use playground equipment at schools.
- Drop your child/children off at school as you would normally do (or according to any school communicated alternative plan).
- Participate in school-based activities such as volunteering in classes and assemblies.
- Use services in a normal way that usually operate at your school e.g. school of

At all times
